INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITION MANAGERS

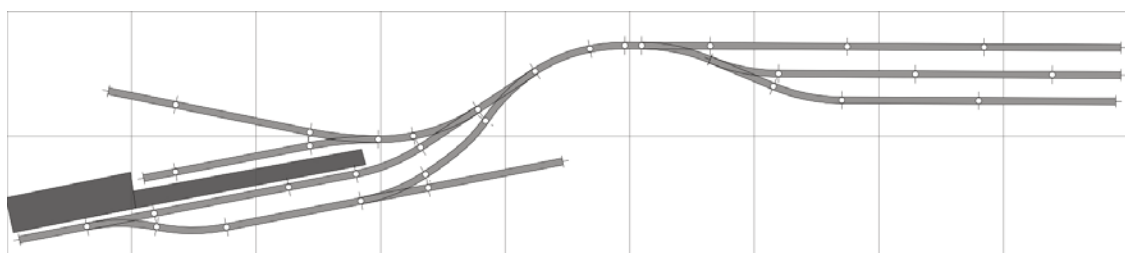
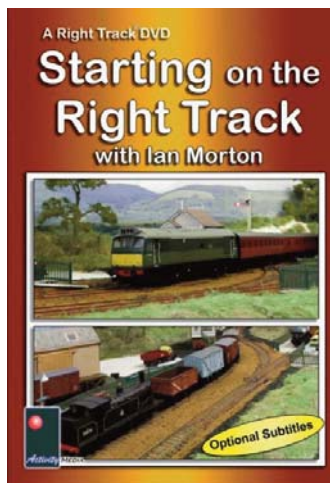
Charmouth was built entirely from ready-to-use items available from model shops along with a few bits from the local DIY store. The 'Shake-the-Box' idea is to use things straight out of the box on the whole. The idea of the concept is that given the standard and range of items available over the counter anyone could do the same from a standing start. Construction was filmed by Activity Media for the DVD *Starting on the Right Track*.

The layout is DCC operated with sectional track and ready-to-run stock.

The real Charmouth, on the Dorset coast between Lyme Regis and Bridport, missed out on the railways however in this version of reality it is served by a BR Southern Region branch line. The normal stock is 1960s steam locomotives although sometimes it is operated as a preserved line when anything goes.

Information about the layout is displayed on a monitor and visitors are welcome to try their hand at operation if they wish.
