The station represents a rural terminus somewhere in middle England served by BR's London Midland Region.

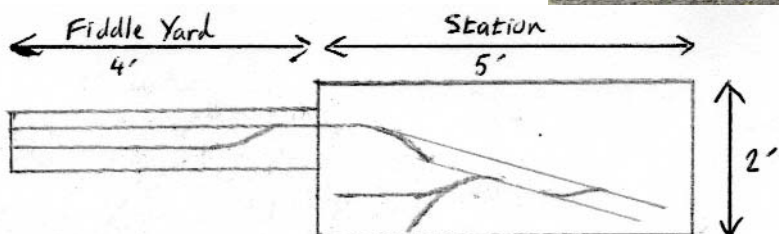
Stock is changed for each operating cycle and covers BR steam, green diesel and blue diesel workings.
